In the Summer of 1984, Foster Rutledge and friends endeavored to repair the gravestone of Robert Rutledge at the Stinsonian Cemetery in Oregon, Illinois. The stone had broken in half across the middle, with the top part falling off. They paid a local person to drill holes into both halves of the stone, into which he inserted dowels to join the halves together. A cement or epoxy was then used to secure and seal the joint.
